

# Locate Permalinks for Films on Demand

This tutorial guides the user through locating a permalink for Films on Demand segments or full videos to share with others in the Clayton State community.

## How to Create a Playlist

- **Step 1** - From <https://www.clayton.edu/library/> click the **Search** tab. Then select **"F"** in the Alphabetical Resources bar.

Use the alphabetical bar to select a single resource for results targeted by subject or format






- **Step 5** – You can add multiple titles to a playlist. (1) Click Playlist. (2) Click “Create New Playlist” and give your playlist a name. Click **Save**



- **Step 6** – Add additional titles to your list. First, close the pop up window by clicking the “X”



- **Step 7** – We can add a segment to our playlist by clicking “Add to”



- **Step 8** – Click **“Add to Existing Playlist”**. Select your playlist from the dropdown menu. Click **“Save”**




